School Requests

With respect to school requests we are seeking to fund grants to provide teachers with the materials they need to implement a program or project or unit that will support student successes at school. We are more likely to grant funds to teachers in support of programs that are directly related to a particular school's class academic needs necessary to improve or sustain them.

Please attach a description of your project, program, or unit of instruction using the attached application. What will students experience? How will this project impact student success? Please write at least a paragraph or two describing your project, program, or unit stating what you hope the outcome for your students will be as a result of this experience.

Local Organization Requests

We are also looking to grant funds to non-school related programs provided by local organizations for citizens of this community in need consistent with the primary mission of the organization. When you prepare your comments in support of your request please keep this in mind. Please write at least a paragraph or two on a separate sheet of paper describing your project or program stating what you hope to accomplish with these funds.

The size of our grants are generally within in the range of \$100-\$500, however, the Foundation may award requests in excess the \$500 if it is felt needed and appropriate, and as additional funds may be available.

We are requiring that all applications be received on, or postmarked on or before **Friday, May 27, 2016.** Checks to successful applicants will be distributed during the month of July or early August, 2016. **Late applications cannot be accepted.**
